## A Record MDA Fundraiser for Team Laura Beth in Atlanta

January 8, 2011 – Atlanta, GA – More than 80 friends and family members supporting Laura Beth Jacquin attended the 2010 MDA Walk of Hope held at ZOO ATLANTA on November 6<sup>th</sup>. Laura Beth and her family have raised over \$110,000 in donations since 2002, with most of the contributions designated for "Seek-A-Miracle", a non-profit organization associated with the MDA and FARA that provides all of its funds to support research to cure Friedreich's Ataxia, one of over 40 illnesses that the MDA supports. Donations are still coming in and a final team total will be determined in late December.

Laura Beth graduated in 2009 from Berry College in Rome, GA with an interdisciplinary degree in psychology, education, family studies and art. She was diagnosed with Friedreich's Ataxia, a progressive, neuromuscular illness twelve years ago.
